The South Australian Government's Department for Infrastructure and Transport has introduced a new guideline to help eliminate criminal and unlawful behaviour on construction sites.

The Unacceptable Behaviours Guideline (the Guide) initiative is a cross-government effort to address and report unacceptable behaviour on transport infrastructure projects.

To help identify unacceptable behaviours, the Guide provides examples of what these might be, including workplace health and safety breaches, criminal behaviour, improper industry activity, and corrupt conduct. It also includes mechanisms and information about how to report unacceptable behaviours.

The Department has worked closely with industry to ensure the Guide is relevant and fit for purpose.

What the Guide does

The [Unacceptable Behaviours Guide](#) sets clear expectations for behaviour on project sites, explains what behaviours are unacceptable and outlines how to report unacceptable behaviours. Unacceptable behaviours include:

- criminal behaviour
- corrupt conduct
- improper industrial activity
- workplace health and safety breaches.

Who it applies to

The guide applies to all DIT projects. The expectations in the guide apply to all suppliers and their employees.

Reporting unacceptable behaviours
