## **Respect the Wires**

The overhead wires and infrastructure along the Gawler rail line are electrified.

They are dangerous if interfered with, carrying 25,000 volts of electricity. Things you need to remember are:

Stand behind the white lines when waiting at a station. The new trains will be quieter and faster and may not be stopping at all stations.




Always use the dedicated


overpasses and pedestrian footpaths to access railway stations.

Electrical wires are dangerous, so remember **not to play or walk near the train tracks.** 

Only cross at level crossings and at recognised pedestrian crossings. Don't take shortcuts along or across the railway tracks.

Pay attention, look up and around, listen, and **be aware of your** surroundings at all times.
