# Respect the Wires

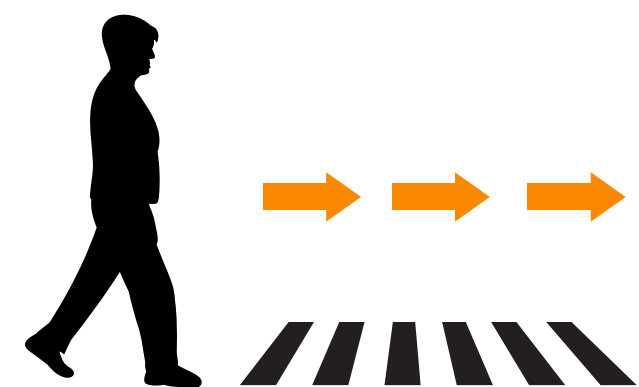
**The overhead wires and infrastructure along the Gawler rail line are electrified.**

**They are dangerous if interfered with, carrying 25,000 volts of electricity. Things you need to remember are:**

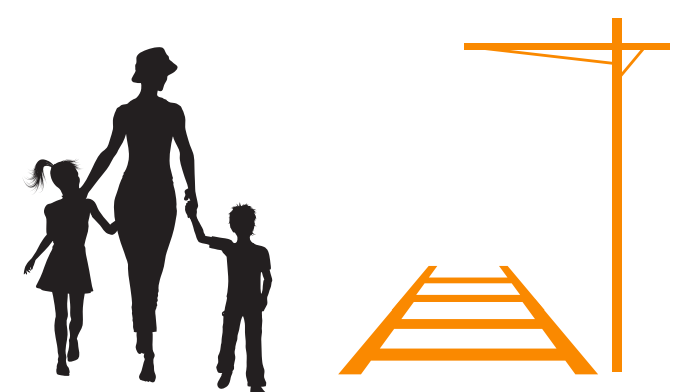
**Stand behind the white lines when waiting at a station.** The new trains will be quieter and faster and may not be stopping at all stations.



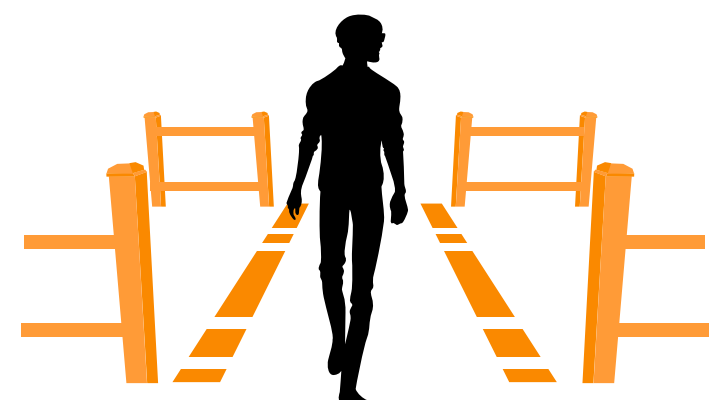
**Always use the dedicated overpasses and pedestrian footpaths** to access railway stations.



Electrical wires are dangerous, so remember **not to play or walk near the train tracks.**



Only cross at level crossings and at recognised pedestrian crossings. **Don't take shortcuts along or across the railway tracks.**



Pay attention, look up and around, listen, and **be aware of your surroundings at all times.**
