

Cross Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

Clinton Avenue temporary closure and nightworks

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$61 million to upgrade the Cross Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As part of this project, the existing overhead SA Power Networks (SAPN) infrastructure (stobie poles and overhead connections) near the project area will be removed and connected to a new underground network. Night works to install the new underground network along Fullarton Road will be undertaken shortly at Clinton Avenue, Myrtle Bank.

What to expect

Works will occur on the western end of Clinton Avenue (adjacent to Fullarton Road) and will involve service locating, trench excavation and installation of the new SAPN infrastructure.

To minimise the impact to road users, **these works will be undertaken at night**. Works are scheduled to commence on **Monday, 11 July 2022, and are expected to be completed the morning of Tuesday, 19 July 2022**, weather permitting. Hours of work are between 7pm and 6am. No works will be undertaken on Friday and Saturday night.

To safely facilitate these works, **Clinton Avenue will be temporarily closed at Fullarton Road during the works**. Motorists will need to detour via Ferguson Avenue and Myrtle Avenue or Ringarooma Avenue and Hexham Avenue. Refer to the map overleaf for details. Please follow local detour signage and traffic controller instructions.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible. Access to properties will be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.
