Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

Realigned Main Avenue and signalised junction opening

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As part of this project, Main Avenue has been realigned and a new signalised intersection has been constructed at the Glen Osmond Road junction with Main Avenue, Frewville.

What to expect

The new Main Avenue alignment and signalised intersection will be open to traffic from 6am on Friday, 18 August 2023.

The new junction includes a sheltered right turn lane from Glen Osmond Road into Main Avenue and signalised pedestrian crossings. The new junction will improve safety and access into and out of nearby businesses.

An indented bus bay is being constructed on Glen Osmond Road, just west of the new Main Avenue junction. This will open to traffic in late August 2023.

The current alignment of Main Avenue will remain operational until the opening of the new alignment.

Following the opening of the new alignment, the current Main Avenue alignment will close at the junction of Glen Osmond Road, with a section of the road to remain in place to provide access via Chessington Avenue to and from Frewville Foodland.
