

Sturt Highway Corridor Upgrade

Pavement Rehabilitation Works

We are upgrading the Sturt Highway, between Gawler and Renmark, to improve safety and traffic efficiency for road all users. The upgrades are jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian governments (20%)

When

Ongoing until mid-May 2024, weather permitting

Hours of operation

Sunday to Friday between 6am and 5pm

Where

Sturt Highway – between Bower Boundary Road and Stonefield Road

What's happening:

Pavement rehabilitation is continuing on the Sturt Highway, between Bower Boundary Road, Steinfeld and Stonefield Road, Annadale.

How this affects you:

To do this work safely, the Sturt Highway will continue to be reduced to a single lane of traffic with traffic signals in place to control the flow of traffic during work hours. Outside of working hours speed restrictions will remain in place throughout the work area, however, **the Sturt Highway will remain open at all times.**

Due to the nature of works being undertaken, from Monday 29 April 2024 until Saturday 4 May 2024, the **Sturt Highway between Bower Boundary Road and Stonefield Road will need to be reduced to a single lane, both day and night** (outside of work hours), with temporary traffic signals in place to control the flow of traffic.

After this period, work hours will return to normal, with works occurring during the day and all lanes on the Sturt Highway reopening after hours. Speed restrictions will be in place as required. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs.
