Our urban and landscape design strategy is underpinned by the recognition that these sites are part of a memorable journey from the City to the Sea.

Reflecting on the history of the human movement both pre and post-colonial development, the notion of overland travel has long been important to people of the Adelaide plains.

Connecting places, cultural stories, natural landscape typologies and waterways are all embedded references that are represented through the design of structures and the public realm, revealing stories about the important places along the journey.

Key themes include:

- The Black Forest
- The Alluvial Plains and Grassy Woodlands
- The Sturt River
- Places of intersection
- Tracks 'Tanga' (Kurna language)
