The \$500 million program is funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments over 10 years.

What's happening

We are installing new road lighting at the intersection of Augusta Highway and Pareora Road in Port Wakefield to improve safety for all road users.

How this affects you

To undertake these works safely, speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the area during work hours. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and observe signage.

Augusta Highway will remain open at all times.

Outside of work hours, all traffic restrictions will be removed.
