

Active Pedestrian Crossing

Jane Street, West Croydon – upcoming pedestrian and cyclist detours

The State Government is improving safety and accessibility along the rail network and have commenced construction of the Activated Pedestrian Crossing at Jane Street, West Croydon.

What's happening

The works will include the installation of concrete for new accessible ramps, designed to facilitate safe crossing of the railway line and provide access to Day and Euston Terrace.

How this affects you

The existing Jane Street pedestrian crossing will be closed between Monday 30 September and Sunday 13 October 2024.

Pedestrians and cyclists are asked to use the West Croydon Railway Station subway or the pedestrian crossing at Brown and Malcolm Streets as detours during this time.

Traffic management signs and directions will be in place while works are in progress.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, we will try to minimise disturbance as much as practically possible.
