Dukes Highway – works notice

We are improving the safety and reliability of national freight routes

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$500 million (80:20) over 10 years to improve the safety and reliability of national freight routes.

This includes the upgrade of Stuart Highway, Augusta Highway, and Dukes Highway.

What's happening

We will be carrying out a total of 23 km of resurfacing work on the Dukes Highway at various locations between Tailern Bend and Bordertown. This work will take place intermittently from December 2024 until early February 2025.

These improvements will enhance the road surface and increase safety for all road users.

How this affects you

To safely undertake these works, there will be changes to existing traffic conditions. During working hours, speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the work area. Please follow onsite traffic signage and the directions of traffic controllers.

Outside of working hours, speed restrictions will remain in place as needed subject to onsite conditions.

We thank you for your patience and understanding while we complete these important works.
