Works Notice

We are making it safer and more convenient for pedestrians to cross St Bernards Road

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional, urban roads, footpaths and cycle paths around South Australia. The \$168 million Road Safety Program is jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments over three years.

What's happening

We are installing a new Pedestrian Actuated (push button) Crossing on St Bernards Road, between Karawirra Avenue and Reid Avenue, Hectorville. Works will include:

- A new Pedestrian Actuated (push button) Crossing.
- Upgraded pedestrian ramps
- Upgraded centre median.
- Upgraded street lighting.
- New line marking and road signage.

This will improve pedestrian safety and access to nearby retail shops, businesses and homes, while improving pedestrian connectivity across St Bernards Road.

How this affects you

St Bernards Road will remain open to traffic at all times.

To do these works safely, there will be changes to existing traffic conditions for the duration of the project. **During work hours, St Bernards Road will be reduced to a single lane under speed restrictions.** Please plan your trips, follow the direction of onsite traffic controllers and observe onsite signage.
