

South Road, Mile End Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated Crossing

Project Update

We are making it safer and more convenient for pedestrians and cyclists to cross South Road

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional, urban roads, footpaths and cycle paths around South Australia. The \$168 million Road Safety Program is jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments over three years.

What's happening

We are installing a new Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated (push button) Crossing (BPAC) on South Road at the intersection of Roebuck Street and King Street, Mile End.

This will improve pedestrian and cyclists' safety and access to nearby retail shops, businesses and homes, while improving bicycle and pedestrian connectivity across South Road.

Works are recommencing with service relocation works from Tuesday, 28 January 2025 with major works commencing from Sunday, 2 February 2025.

How this affects you

South Road will remain open to traffic at all times.

To do this work safely, speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the work area with traffic controllers controlling the flow of traffic. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers and follow the speed limits and signs. Outside of work hours, speed restrictions will remain in place.

Day Works

Monday to Friday between 7am and 5pm

Night Works

Sunday to Thursday between the hours of 7pm and 6am

Some Saturday works may also be required.

Access to and from South Road via Roebuck Street and King Street will be intermittently closed, with local detours in place. Additional local access detours will be in place intermittently until all works are complete. Please follow onsite signage and the directions of traffic controllers.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained. Advance notice will be provided if temporary access restrictions are required.

To minimise traffic impacts regular night works will be required.

There may be some noise from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through the area. Some areas may have restricted access, with traffic controllers on site to guide you to alternative routes.

There will be temporary impacts to bus stops in the area, please check the latest updates on scheduled services at www.adelaidemetro.com.au

Following construction of the new BPAC Bus Stop 4A South Road, West Side, will be permanently relocated approximately 70 metres south of the current location.
