

Streaky Bay Jetty Remediation

Project update

We are upgrading the Streaky Bay Jetty to improve the jetty's structural integrity and lifespan.

These works are being undertaken as part of the SA Jetties Renewal Program which is designed to ensure ongoing public access to jetties, that provide significant economic, social, and environmental benefits for communities.

What's happening

Works are progressing well and will be completed early October 2025. The jetty will then re-open to the public.

The upgrade includes installation of new structural piles, cross brace brackets and fenders to facilitate vessels berthing and mooring.

How this affects you

From early October the construction lay down area located between Alfred Terrace and the foreshore will reduce in size. Some site offices will remain in place while Maritime Constructions undertake works on behalf of the District Council of Streaky Bay.

The District Council of Streaky Bay's Jetty Pool was closed for safety reasons during construction.
