

# Porter Street, Liverpool Street and Railway Place Junction Upgrade

## Project update

### We're upgrading the Porter Street, Liverpool Street and Railway Place intersection in Port Lincoln

These works are jointly funded 50:50 by the Australian and South Australian governments through the Safer Local Roads and Infrastructure Program, which replaces the Heavy Vehicle Safety and Productivity Program (HVSPP).

### Project update

We are upgrading the Porter Street, Liverpool Street (Lincoln Highway) and Railway Place intersection in Port Lincoln to improve freight efficiency, enhance safety and provide better access for pedestrians.

This intersection is used by approximately 10,300 vehicles each day, including more than 1400 heavy vehicles, and forms part of a vital freight and grain transport corridor on the Eyre Peninsula.

The project will include the installation of traffic signals at the intersection, creating a pedestrian crossing on all four approaches, and new line marking, street lighting, kerbing and landscaping.
