



# Adelaide Road and Hawthorn Road Intersection Upgrade, Mount Barker

## Project Update

The South Australian Government has committed \$80 million to upgrade the Adelaide Road and Hawthorn Road intersection in Mount Barker, helping to reduce congestion and improve local connectivity.

## About the project

The Adelaide Road and Hawthorn Road intersection upgrade will include:

- Installation of traffic signals.
- A new dedicated right turn lane from Adelaide Road onto Hawthorn Road.
- New dedicated right and left turn lanes from Hawthorn Road onto Adelaide Road.
- Improved pedestrian crossing facilities across Adelaide Road.
- Road widening and intersection improvements to support future traffic growth.

## What's happening

As part of our transport planning, we are undertaking site investigation works on Adelaide Road and Hawthorn Road, Mount Barker (see work zone map overleaf). Works will involve surveying and service investigations at various locations along the road and footpath.

These works will be undertaken mostly during the daytime, with some night works required.

## How this affects you

To safely carry out these works there will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed restrictions will be in place on Adelaide Road and Hawthorn Road in Mount Barker. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

We'll maintain access for properties throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to restrict driveway access temporarily. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times during works.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling throughout the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. When required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

## Community engagement

We look forward to connecting with the community throughout the delivery of this project, including giving local residents, businesses and road users opportunities to stay informed, provide feedback and share their thoughts about the proposed upgrades.

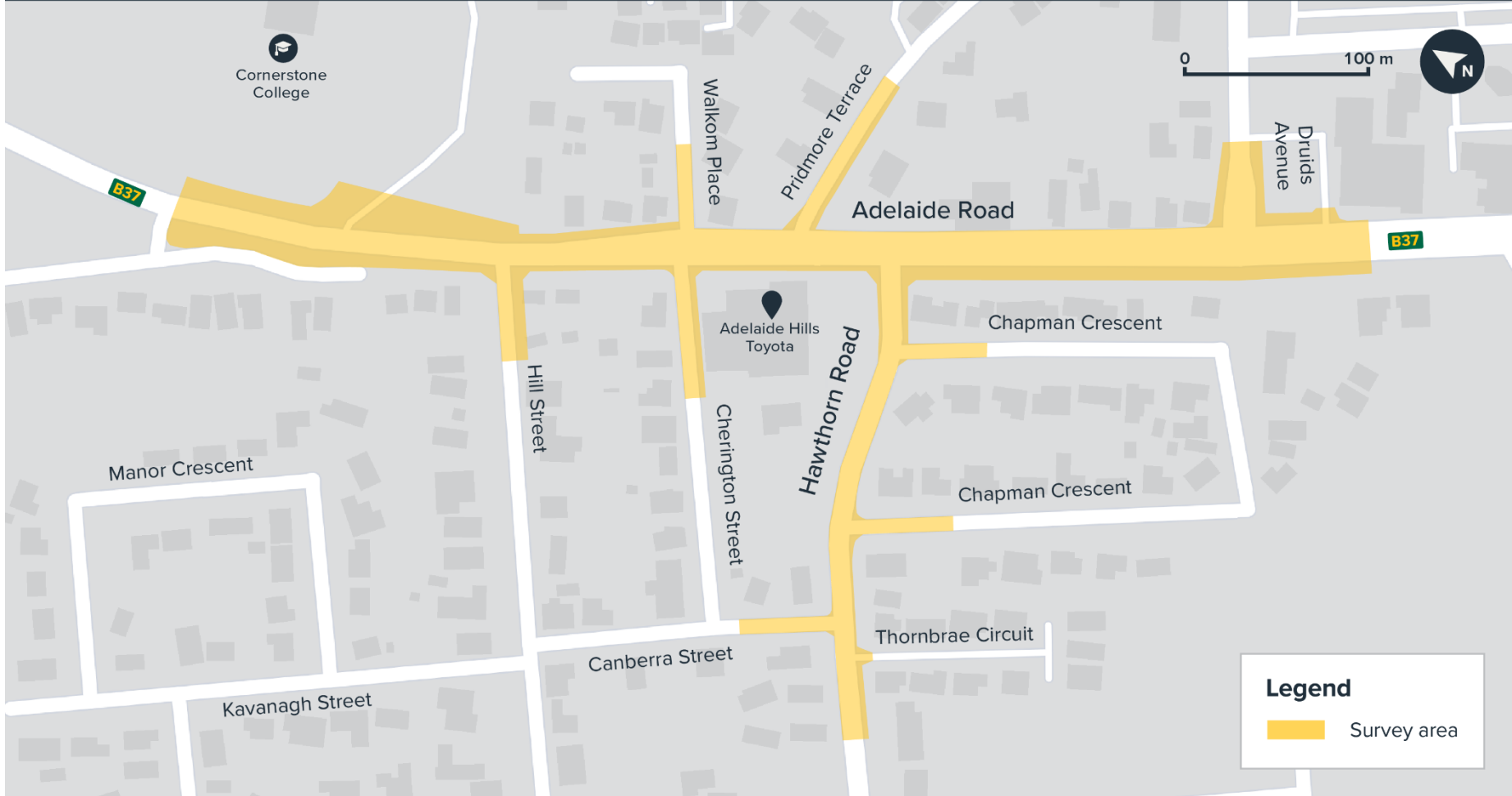
