

Lefevre Peninsula Upgrades Project

Works notice – September 2026

We are upgrading the road network in Osborne to improve safety and support growth in the area.

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly funded 50:50 towards the development of the northern Lefevre Peninsula, one of the key economic growth areas in South Australia supporting industries including the defence expansion.

What's happening

As part of early works being undertaken at the corner of Victoria Road and Pelican Point Road, night works are required. These works will be undertaken from 7.30pm Wednesday 9 September 2026 for approximately one week, weather permitting.

These works are being undertaken at night to minimise disruption to traffic during the day at this high-volume intersection.

How this affects you

Local residents

Light towers will be installed to provide temporary lighting during night works. Light towers will be positioned to illuminate the work zone and minimise impact to residents. Access to properties will be maintained however we will notify you in advance if temporary access restrictions are required.

Mitigation measures are implemented to minimise any noise disturbance as much as possible.
