Gawler Rail Electrification Project


Works Notification

As part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) advises that the rail level crossing at Pym Street will be temporarily reduced to one lane.

Location: Pym Street Rail Crossing between Exeter Terrace and Devonport Terrace, Prospect (refer to map).

When: Wednesday, 26 February, between 9am and 4pm.

Train services will not be impacted by these works



What you can expect:

- Noise from a hydro-vacuum machine used to identify underground services within the rail corridor.
- A truck with equipment accompanied by 1-2 light vehicles.
- Project personnel operating within the rail corridor.
- The level crossing will be reduced to one-way traffic while the works are being undertaken, with a detour in place for traffic impacted by the closed lane.
- Traffic management crews will ensure access to your property is maintained at all times.

Please follow directions from staff and traffic signage to ensure your safety and that of our crews. Thank you for your patience as we undertake this important project.
