Gawler Rail Electrification Project

Hawker Street, Ovingham, level crossing - temporary closure

As part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) advises that day and night works will be undertaken at the Hawker Street level crossing requiring a temporary closure with detours in place.

Location: Hawker Street level crossing, and within the rail corridor between Gilbert Street and Trembath Street, Ovingham (refer to map).

When: From 6am Sunday, 5 July, continuously until 6pm Thursday, 9 July, weather permitting

Traffic management: Hawker Street level crossing will be closed to motorists with detours in place. Speed and lane restrictions will apply in the vicinity of the works. Signage and traffic management will be in place to advise motorists of the changed conditions and to assist pedestrians to cross the rail line.



What you can expect:

- Construction plant equipment including a hydro-vacuum machine, excavator, cranage and lighting towers, and other construction vehicles
- Noise from construction machinery used to undertake drilling, trenching and signalling changeover works.
- Project personnel operating within the rail corridor.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained, please follow the direction of traffic management crews.
- Access to residential properties and businesses will be maintained at all times

Every effort will be made to minimise noise and disruption to nearby residents and businesses during the works. Thank you for your patience as we undertake this important project.
