# Torrens to Darlington (T2D)

Project Assessment | December 2021

## Building the missing link

Set to unlock Adelaide's traffic network, the Torrens to Darlington (T2D) Project is the final 10.5km section of the North-South Corridor.

Using a combination of tunnels, a lowered and surface-level motorway, as well as overpasses and underpasses at key intersections, the T2D Project will create 78km of non-stop traffic light-free motorway between Gawler and Old Noarlunga.

By moving thousands of vehicles into tunnels, and bypassing 21 sets of lights, the T2D Project will connect communities across Greater Adelaide. It will ensure people, produce and products arrive where they need to be, sooner and safer, making the T2D Project a positive contribution to businesses, employment, education and the lives of South Australian families.

## What is in the Project Assessment?

The Project Assessment process ensures robust environmental, social, and engineering investigations are undertaken to identify potential project impacts, and to identify strategies to mitigate impacts.

The process includes detailed environmental and social investigations based on the Reference Design. They include:

- Traffic and transport
- Social and community
- Business and economic
- Planning, zoning and land use
- Land tenure
- Urban design and visual amenity
- Ground conditions
- Surface and groundwater
- Air quality
- Human health and wellbeing
- Noise and vibration
- Ecology
- Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal heritage
- Sustainability
- Environmental management, mitigation and monitoring framework

Community feedback gathered through this process and as part of consultation on the Project Assessment Report will be used to identify strategies to manage potential impacts and refine the Project during the next phase, the development of its detailed design process.

## Why do a Project Assessment Report?

Released for community feedback in 2022, the Project Assessment Report will:

- describe the construction and operational components of the T2D Project
- document the anticipated extent and duration of environmental and social impacts of the T2D Project
- inform the detailed design for construction
- outline the proposed approach to manage and minimise project impacts and detail positive outcomes and opportunities
- summarise the community and stakeholder engagement approach and findings
- provide a summary of the city-shaping initiatives being developed with the community.


The findings from the Project Assessment process and its technical investigations will also support environmental approval processes.

## Where will the Project Assessment be available?

In a first for a South Australian transport infrastructure project, the Project Assessment will be online.

Accessed via the T2D Project website, the digital platform will improve community access to the Project Assessment and the environmental and social investigation reports. It will allow seamless interactive features including image sliders and videos that show before and after views, interactive maps and the ability to contribute to feedback from anywhere, anytime.

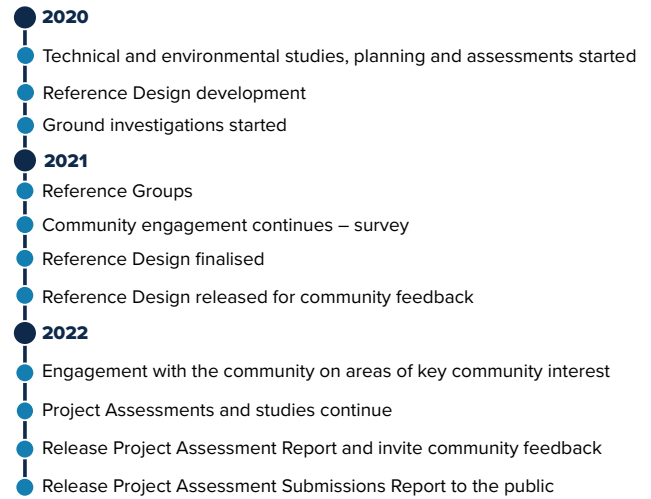
