

# Tram Grade Separations Project

## Morphett Road Level Crossing

### Maxwell Terrace temporary road closure

**The Australian and South Australian governments recently committed funding towards a planning study to investigate the removal of the level crossing where the Glenelg tram line crosses Morphett Road, Morphettville. These works form part of the Tram Grade Separations Project.**

As you may be aware, ground investigation works have commenced to further develop an understanding of the underlying soil and groundwater conditions to inform the early planning and design phase.

#### What to expect

As part of this work, a temporary closure of **Maxwell Terrace, between Morphett Road and Duggan Avenue** is required. The temporary road closure and works will commence on **Friday, 4 November and are expected to be complete Thursday 17 November 2022, weather permitting**. Works will be undertaken between the hours of **7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday** with the closure and detour remaining in place outside of working hours overnight. The road will re-open each weekend between 6pm Friday and 7am Monday.

Motorists will be required to detour via Duggan Avenue and Gowrie Avenue. Refer to the map overleaf for details. Please follow local detour signage and traffic controller instructions. Local traffic will be maintained.

Access to properties will be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time, and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there will be some restricted pedestrian access and detours. Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community. We encourage you to register your details with the project team to receive information as it becomes available.
