Brighton Road and Edwards Street Junction upgrade

Commercial Road temporary closure

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly funded \$40 million (50:50) to be spent in the Holdfast Bay region. \$30 million will be allocated to upgrade the Brighton Road and Edwards Street junction at South Brighton, and the Brighton Road, Wattle Street and Dunrobin Road intersection at Hove. \$10 million will be allocated to upgrade the Automatic Train Protection (ATP) system on the Seaford line.

As part of this project, civil work and cable hauling, including trenching and directional boring works will be undertaken on Edwards Street, and Commercial Road, Brighton.

What to expect

Works are expected to commence from Monday, 23 January 2023, and are expected to be completed Monday, 30 January 2023, weather permitting.

Works will be undertaken during the day between 7am and 7pm, Monday to Saturday. No works will be undertaken on Thursday, 26 January 2023.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

The junction of Edward Street and Brighton Road will remain open to traffic at all times, however a temporary detour will be in place for Commercial Road, between Edwards Street and Rutland Avenue, on Monday, 23 January 2023, weather permitting. Motorists needing to access Commercial Road will be detoured via Trevelion Avenue and Rutland Avenue. See map overleaf for details.

Speed restrictions will be in place when workers are on site, with temporary footpath detours on Edwards Street. Directional signage will be in place to guide pedestrians and cyclists in the area. Public Transport will not be impacted by these works. Please take extra care when travelling through the area. Observe traffic management signs, speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers while the works are undertaken.

Access to properties and businesses in the area will be maintained during works, however, in the event that private property access is impacted, the project team will contact you directly, ahead of these works occurring.

Access through the area for emergency services will be maintained at all times.
