South Eastern Freeway Upgrade Project

Works update - Heysen Tunnels ongoing works

Upgrade works are continuing on the Heysen Tunnels to improve safety and provide improved traffic management and incident response capabilities are continuing.

What's happening:

As works progress, tunnel closures will alternate between the Crafers bound (up-track) and Adelaide bound (down-track) tunnels for the life of the project.

How this affects you:

While work is occurring in one tunnel, that tunnel will be closed, each night, and traffic in both directions will use the other tunnel with a contraflow arrangement in place.

At times, other work may also be occurring in and around the Heysen Tunnels.

Changes to traffic conditions will be communicated in advance via on site messaging boards.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place around work areas so please observe signage and take extra care when travelling through the area.

In the event of a bushfire, other emergency, or on catastrophic fire days, all lanes will be open in both tunnels and posted speed limits will be reinstated for both carriageways.

Access for emergency service vehicles and to all safety ramps will be always maintained during these works.


