

Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package

Lobethal Road Investigation works

We are delivering the Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package to upgrade key strategic arterial roads in the region. The road improvements will support economic growth, improve road safety and increase fire resilience. The \$150 million initiative is jointly funded by the Australian Government (80%) and South Australian Government (20%) over five years.

What's happening:

Site investigation works including geotechnical drilling and survey works will be undertaken along Lobethal Road between Ashton and Lenswood. These investigations will support planning for potential upgrades along this road.

How this affects you:

To do this works safely, Lobethal Road will be reduced to a single lane with traffic controllers on site to control the direction of traffic with reduced speed limits in place. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signage.

Outside of working hours, speed and lane restrictions will be removed.

Access to properties will be maintained for the duration of works, and we will ensure every effort is made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and roads.

Minor noise disturbances can be expected while works are being undertaken, but we will minimise any disturbance to residents as much as practically possible.
