

Freight Highway Upgrade Program

Safety Barrier Installation – Stuart Highway

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$500 million (80:20) over 10 years to improve the safety and reliability of national freight routes.

This includes the upgrade of Stuart Highway, Augusta Highway and Dukes Highway in South Australia.

What's happening:

We are installing safety barriers on the Stuart Highway, south of Pimba, to improve road safety along this important national freight route.

How this affects you:

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe while we undertake these works.

During work hours the Stuart Highway will be reduced to a single lane throughout the works area. Traffic signage and traffic controllers will be in place to control the flow of traffic.

Outside of working hours both lanes will be open with speed restrictions in place as required, subject to onsite conditions.

Please plan your trips, drive with caution around workers and follow the directions of traffic controllers and signage.
