PSPETH006 Uphold the Values and Principles of Public Service

This course describes the performance outcomes, skills and knowledge required to demonstrate ethical conduct required of those in public service. Some of the topics covered include:

- Confirm interpretation of ethical values and principles with senior staff
- Use public resources ethically, ensuring conflicts of interests are declared and documented
- Apply ethical standards in all work relationships
- Resolve or refer ethical problems in accordance with organisational protocols
- Identify and report unethical conduct in accordance with organisational protocols
