

Princes Highway Upgrade

Remediation works update

Improving long term safety and efficiency for all road users

We are delivering infrastructure upgrades on the Princes Highway, from Meningie to the South Australian/Victorian border. These upgrades are jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian governments (80:20).

What's happening

Remediation works on the Princes Highway will be ongoing until May 2025.

Works will be undertaken at various locations along Princes Highway between Meningie and the South Australia/Victoria border, and on Jubilee Highway West at the Suttontown Road, O'Leary Road and Wehl Street North roundabouts, Mount Gambier.

How this affects you

Princes Highway

The Princes Highway will remain open to all vehicles at all times.

To keep everyone safe and ensure these works can be completed as quickly as possible there will be changes to traffic conditions throughout the work areas while works are in progress.

During work hours the Princes Highway will be reduced to a single lane where works are being undertaken under speed restrictions (works will move progressively around the work sites). Traffic signage and traffic controllers will be in place to guide motorists through work areas.

Restrictions will remain in place until all works are complete in May 2025.
