

# Belair Road retaining walls maintenance works

Project update

#### Work update

Essential maintenance work along Belair Road, below the Windy Point Lookout at Lynton are progressing well. This essential work is required to preserve the long-term structural integrity of this section of Belair Road.

We are pleased to announce that the main part of this work, to upgrade the retaining walls, is complete.

This will allow us to restore Belair Road to two way traffic from 7pm Friday 11 April 2025.

Some minor activities will continue where required, both day and night.

Day works will be Monday to Friday between 9am and 3pm.

Nightworks as required Sunday to Thursday 7pm to 6am.

To keep everyone safe speed and some lane restrictions will be in place. Two-way traffic will be maintained during this work.

No project work will be undertaken during the Easter holidays and Anzac Day from **Thursday**, **17 April** to **Sunday**, **27 April 2025** with Belair Road fully open to traffic both day and night.

Please observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Please plan ahead and expect some delays.









Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however we will manage the work to minimise disturbances as much as practically possible.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

## **Upcoming work**

Asphalting maintenance works will be undertaken along Belair Road, from the intersection of Springbank Road to Windy Point Lookout Carpark and will commence in May 2025.

To minimise disruption to all road users, the asphalt work will be undertaken at night under a road closure.

More information about this work will be provided in advance.

In the event of a catastrophic fire danger day, there will be no works scheduled on Belair Road. The road will be open under traffic management to maintain a safe evacuation route. For more information, refer to the <a href="Emergency access fact sheet">Emergency access fact sheet</a>.
