

Grand Junction Road, Gepps Cross Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated Crossing

Project Update

We are making it safer for pedestrians and cyclists to cross Grand Junction Road.

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional and urban roads, footpaths and cycling paths around South Australia. The \$168 million Road Safety Program is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments over three years.

What's happening

Works are progressing on the new Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated Crossing (push button) on Grand Junction Road at Montrose Avenue.

Day works will continue to late December 2025, with intermittent night works required to minimise traffic impacts to road users. Major works will be complete late 2025 with final line marking occurring in early February 2026.

No works will occur over the holiday period between 20 December 2025 and 4 January 2026.

How this affects you

To safely undertake works, Montrose Avenue at the junction with Grand Junction Road, will continue to be closed until the end of November. Local access detours will remain in place during this time. **Intermittent day closures of Montrose Avenue will occur through December until all works are complete.**

Speed and lane restrictions will continue to be in place during work hours, with speed restrictions remaining in place at all times.

Two-way traffic on Grand Junction Road will be maintained at all times.

Some areas may have restricted access, with traffic controllers and on-site signage to guide you to alternative routes. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained. Advance notice will be provided if temporary access restrictions are required.
