

# Kings Road BPAC and Shared Use Path, Salisbury Downs

## Night works

### We are improving safety and connectivity for pedestrians and cyclists on Kings Road in Salisbury Downs

We are delivering a new Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated (push button) Crossing (BPAC) on Kings Road and a new Shared Use Path between Kings Road and York Terrace, adjacent to the Gawler railway corridor in Salisbury Downs.

## What's happening

Works on the new Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated (push button) Crossing on Kings Road are underway and progressing well.

**To safely undertake the next stage of works, works will be undertaken at night. This work will take place from Sunday 7 December 2025 to Friday 19 December 2025. No day works will be undertaken during this period.**

No work will take place after 6am Friday 19 December to mid-January 2026. Advance notice will be provided prior to recommencement of works.

## How this affects you

To do this work safely, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress. Speed restrictions will remain in place outside of working hours, as required, until completion.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through work zones. Onsite signage will guide you to other routes if needed.

Access to the Parafield Railway Station car park will be maintained throughout the project. Train services in the area will be maintained, however, please check the latest updates on scheduled services at [adelaidemetro.com.au](http://adelaidemetro.com.au). The existing crossing will remain active until the new BPAC is in operation.

Access for Thomas More College will be maintained.

During works, there may be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum. Thank you for your patience while these important works are undertaken.
