

# Strzelecki Track Upgrade

## Art Baker Lookout to Mount Hopeless Works Notice

**We are improving road safety and network reliability on Strzelecki Track**

### What's happening

As part of the Strzelecki Track Upgrade and Sealing Project, we are undertaking works along the 33-kilometre section between Art Baker Lookout and Mount Hopeless, including pavement rehabilitation, sealing and drainage upgrades.

Works will begin on Wednesday 6 May 2026 and are expected to be completed late 2026.

Works will be undertaken at multiple locations concurrently and move progressively along the Strzelecki Track between Art Baker Lookout and Mount Hopeless.

### How this affects you

To keep everyone safe while works are undertaken, speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout work areas. Speed restrictions will remain in place throughout the area at all times until works are complete.

Please be advised that, due to the unsealed nature of the Strzelecki Track, work areas may be dusty, and road users may have decreased visibility when travelling through work sites.

Please plan your trips, observe signage, and follow the directions of onsite traffic controllers. Before travelling, road users should also check [weather conditions, road warnings and closures](#), as some sections of the Strzelecki Track can be impassable due to floodwaters.
