We are improving road and rail safety at the Grange Road, Hawthorn level crossing

What's happening

We will be undertaking minor finishing works at the Grange Road level crossing on Friday 17 July 2026. Works will include tree trimming to improve visibility, and final line marking on Grange Road.

To minimise impacts to traffic and allow some of these activities to occur safely while passenger rail services are not operating, these works will take place overnight.

How this affects you

There will be some noise during these works including the use of a chainsaw for tree trimming, but we will do our best to keep noise to a minimum.

Traffic management will be in place during the works. Please follow all signage and directions from traffic controllers.

Access to Mitcham Railway Station will be maintained at all times.

We appreciate your patience as we work to deliver these important road and rail safety improvements.
