



Park 'n' Ride Facility at Torrens Park

Project Update

We are building a new Park 'n' Ride facility at the Torrens Park railway station

The State Government has committed \$7 million to deliver the project in Torrens Park, which will improve access to public transport and enhance the overall experience for station users.

Key features proposed as part of the project include:

- A new sealed car park with approximately 38 parking spaces, including two accessible parking bays
- New accessible ramp to Torrens Park railway station
- Access provided from Belair Road, with pedestrian crossing improvements at the Blythewood Road intersection
- Installation of lighting and CCTV
- A secure bike storage cage to support active travel and multi-modal commuting
- New tree planting and landscaping

Community members who are unable to attend an information session will be able to access project information online and contact the project team directly with any questions or feedback.

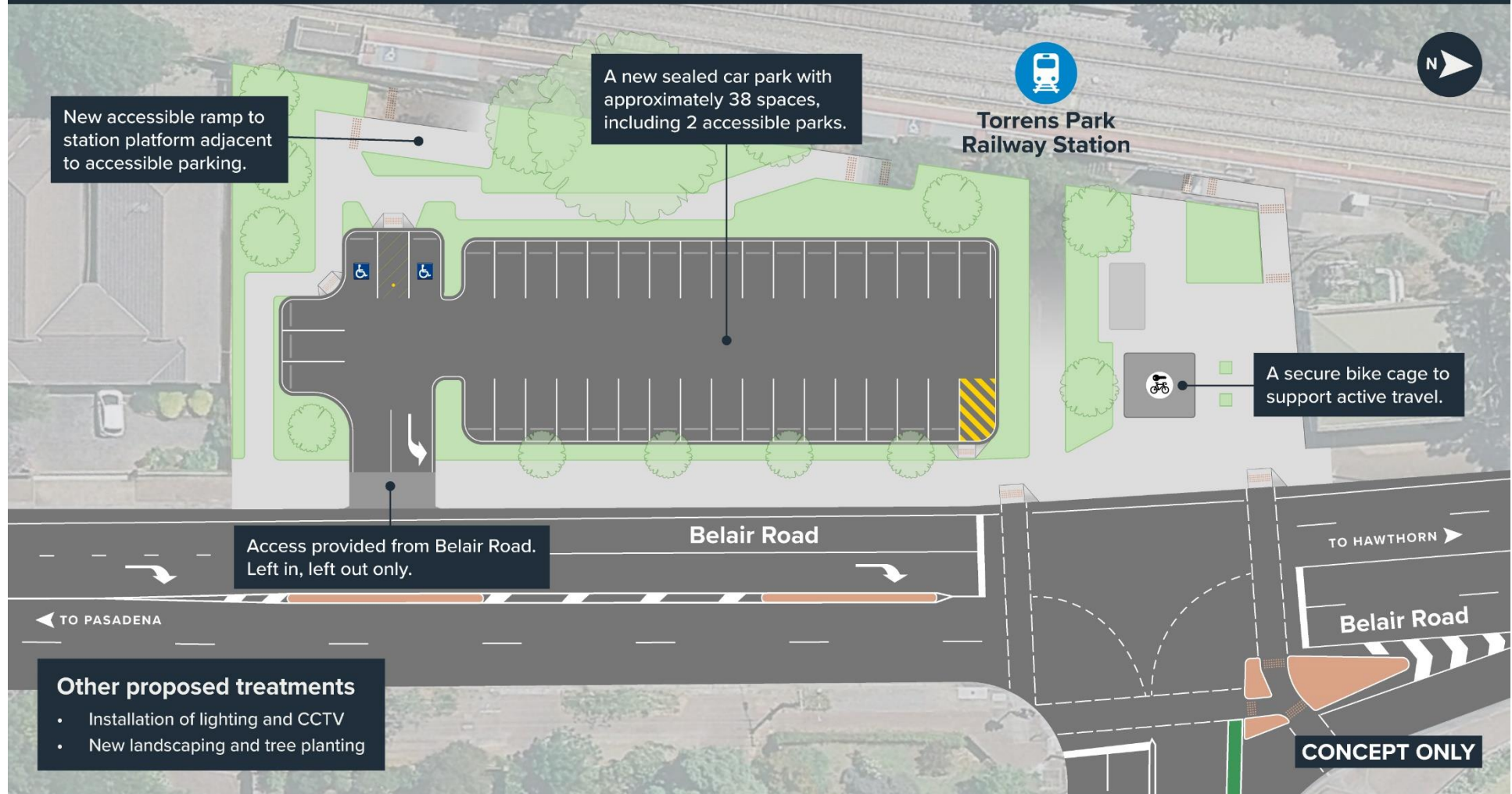
