This venture is in its infancy but has potential to revitalise Granite Island. Aldi & Coles/Bunnings interface with Adelaide Road - Victor Harbor Recommended by Graeme Maxwell (CEO City of Victor Harbor) Aldi and Coles/Bunnings have been granted development approval by the Development Assessment Commission at their nominated locations on Adelaide Road as you enter Victor Harbor. There are consequent infrastructure issues for DPTI and Council related to these developments which council was unable to achieve agreement upon prior to development approval. A site visit will enable a visualisation and discussion on the infrastructure requirements. Torrens Road/Crozier Road Intersection Recommended by Graeme Maxwell (CEO City of Victor Harbor) This intersection is located within the Central Business District and on Victor Harbor's main thorough fare. Torrens Road is a DPTI road while Crozier Road is under the care and control of Council. As a high accident intersection it qualified for black spot funding several years ago but DPTI and Council differed in their opinions about an appropriate traffic treatment. The intersection risks remain and a roundabout is council's desired outcome.

Is this climate change and a sign of things to come? Our modelling suggests that rising sea levels will require \$17.5million of protection investment over the next 30 years to mitigated risks of property inundation and infrastructure damage. 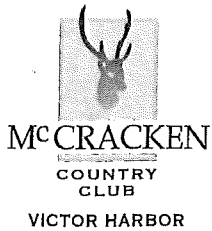

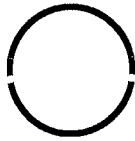
