Farrell Flat bridge and culvert

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) is upgrading the bridge and culvert on Farrell Flat Road near Clare. The \$1.2m project is funded through the Australian Government and State Government funded Regional Bridges Upgrade Program and will improve road safety and increase freight efficiency by upgrading a number of bridges across South Australia's regional road network.

Works are scheduled to commence from Monday, **17 September, and are expected to be completed by late December,** weather permitting, and will include:

- replacing the existing bridge and culvert with wider structures
- installation of new guard rails and bridge barriers

Works will be undertaken from 7am to 5pm, starting on Monday morning and finishing on Saturday afternoon each week until the completion of the project.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times throughout the works and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users wherever possible.

Traffic diversions and speed restrictions will be in place with detours available for all traffic via Slaughterhouse Road and Springfarm Road throughout the course of the works. Road users are advised to follow the direction of traffic management staff and observe signage.
