

Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade

Night Works Notification – August 2020

Dear Resident / Business Owner,

Night works involving trenching for service utilities for the Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade Project will commence on Monday, 10 August 2020, and continue for approximately five weeks.

The Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade Project is jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian Governments. The \$60 million project will improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users.

The service relocation works along Goodwood Road, Springbank Road and Daws Road are being undertaken to facilitate the new intersection realignment. While the majority of these works are being undertaken during the day, night works are now required.

In order to minimise the impact to road users and ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently, works will be undertaken at night **between 7pm and 7am from Monday to Friday, commencing Monday, 10 August 2020**. No works will be undertaken on Saturday or Sunday nights.

Speed, lane restrictions and detours (see map below) will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the intersection will remain open to traffic at all times. Left turn access into Boothby Street from Goodwood Road will be temporarily closed during the first week of the night works. Access into Boothby Street will be detoured via O'Neil Street. Access from Boothby Street onto Goodwood Road will remain open at all times.

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Excavators, tippers, compaction equipment and lighting towers will be used during these works, and some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disruption as much as practically possible.

Access to properties during these works will be maintained, however at times this will be under the assistance of traffic controllers. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Individual service providers such as SA Power Networks, SA Water, Telecommunications providers and Gas Authorities will advise separately of any potential interruptions to services during these works.

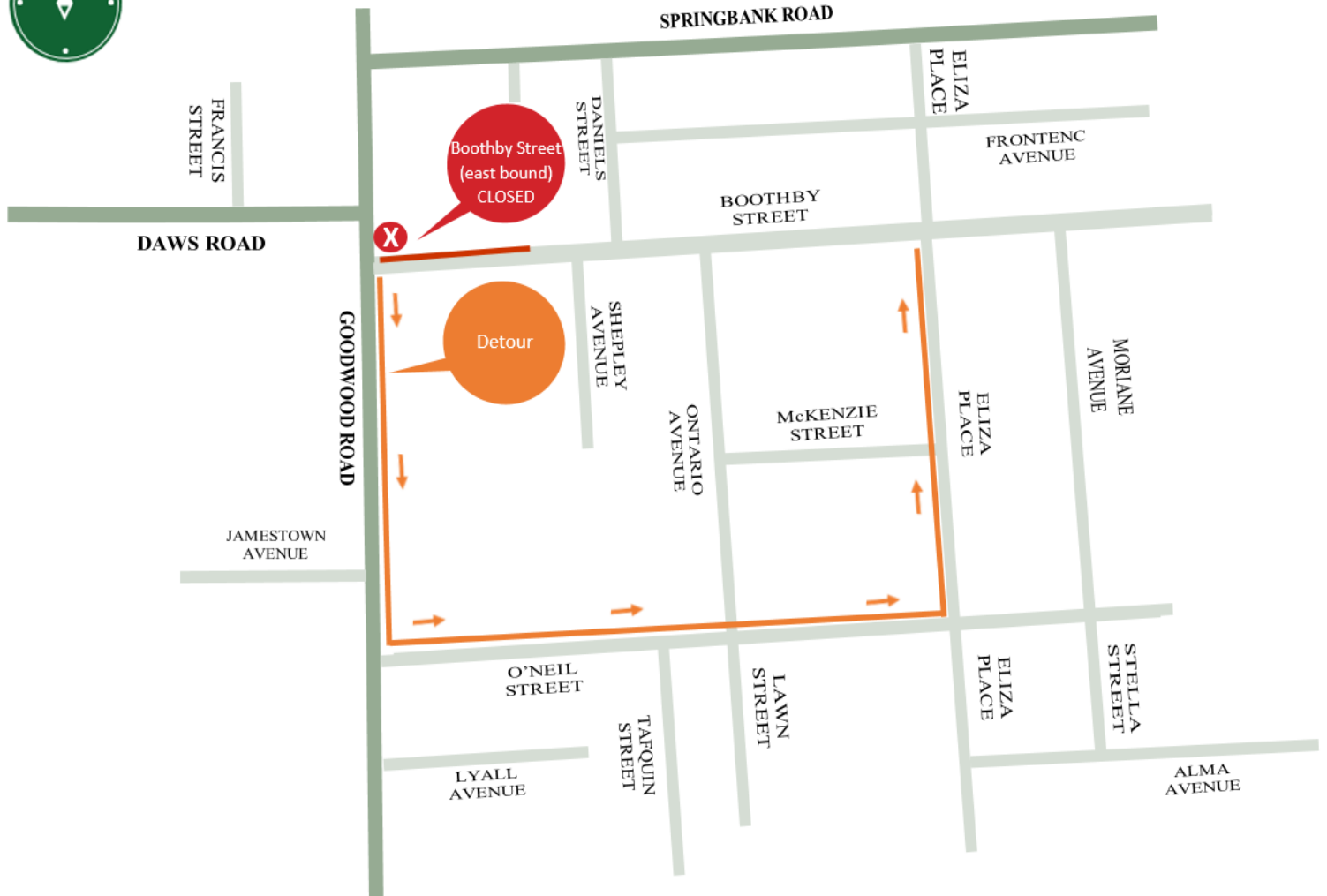
