

## Portrush and Magill Roads Intersection Upgrade

## Night Works

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading the intersection of Portrush and Magill roads to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$98 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

Due to recent inclement weather the first stage of asphalt works will continue until Thursday, 4 November 2021, weather permitting. While the majority of works are occurring during the day, night works are being undertaken to minimise the impact to road users and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently.

Following completion of the first stage of asphalt works, night works will continue through November from Sunday, 7 November 2021, to construct new kerb and median islands and to install new signal and stormwater infrastructure. These works will be undertaken at the intersection and on all approaches to the intersection.

The second stage of asphalt works will commence in late November with further information to be provided.

Hours of work are between 7pm and 6am, from Sunday to Friday. No works will be undertaken on Saturday nights.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed. However, every effort will be made to minimise disruption to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons the footpath and bike lane on the western side of Portrush Road will remain closed between Beulah Road and Dover Street. Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout these works.

Public transport services will not be affected during the works, however if required, advance notice of any temporary changes will be provided at the bus stops and on the Adelaide Metro website <a href="https://www.adelaidemetro.com.au">www.adelaidemetro.com.au</a>
