

# Station Refresh Program Works

## Smithfield, Kudla, Tambelin, Gawler Oval and Gawler Central Railway Stations

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering improvement works at 14 stations along the Gawler rail line. The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly (50:50) committed \$20 million as part of the Gawler Rail Line Station Refresh Program.

Continued works at Smithfield, Kudla, Tambelin, Gawler Oval and Gawler Central railway stations include:

- platform and shelter repairs;
- lighting upgrades;
- fence and furniture installation;
- painting of the station;
- pressure wash and clean up;
- new station signage; and
- new platform line marking.

Works will be undertaken intermittently from **Tuesday, 26 April to Monday, 9 May 2022**, weather permitting. Hours of work during the day are between **6am to 6pm**.

Works are being scheduled in conjunction with testing and commissioning currently underway as part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Pedestrian access will not be affected during these works.

There will be no impact to public transport services during these works as the line is currently closed as part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project. –Substitute bus services will continue to operate during this time.

Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.
