## How to... Add and edit an assessing officer's note





### **Overview**

The option to add 'Assessing Officer Notes' is available from the **Consent Summary** page (for all consent types) during consent verification, assessment, and post decision; excludes the **Development Approval Summary** page, though a note can be added to the consent during development approval.

### Who can see the Assessing Officer Notes?

Only the consent relevant authority staff.

Where consents (planning, land division and/or building) are being assessed by the same relevant authority, the Assessing Officer Notes are not carried over to the next consent; if required, notes can be viewed from the applicable consent.

In scenarios where the consent is reassigned to a different relevant authority, the Assessing Officer Notes option is hidden and the notes are cleared; an event audit entry records the note clearing, in the Event History of the application.
