Brighton Road and Edwards Street Junction upgrade

Site investigation works

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly funded \$40 million (50:50) to be spent in the Holdfast Bay region. \$30 million will be allocated to upgrade the Brighton Road and Edwards Street junction at South Brighton, and the Brighton Road, Wattle Street and Dunrobin Road intersection at Hove. \$10 million will be allocated to upgrade the Automatic Train Protection (ATP) system on the Seaford line.

We received valuable feedback from the local community over the last several months. This feedback will help inform the detailed design, and we thank everyone who provided feedback. Once an updated concept design is ready, we will provide further updates.

Upcoming works

In order to progress with the design development, site investigation works will be undertaken in the vicinity of the junction in the coming weeks. These works are expected to be complete by late 2022, weather permitting.

Service locating works are being undertaken at the intersection of Brighton Road and Edwards Street. These works involve service locating equipment to detect any underground services and potholing works.

The majority of these works will be undertaken during the day between 7am and 7pm, Monday to Saturday. To safely undertake this work, some night works may be required. Night work hours are from 7pm to 6am.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible. Where night works are required, this includes scheduling intrusive works during the early evening where possible.

The junction will remain open to traffic at all times, however temporary lane and speed restrictions may be required when workers are on site. Temporary footpath detours may also be required. If this is the case, directional signage will be in place to guide people walking and riding. Bus stops will not be impacted. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe traffic management signs, speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties and businesses in the area will be maintained at all times during works. Access through the area for emergency services will also be maintained at all times. In the event that private property access is impacted, we will contact you directly ahead of these works occurring.
