Semaphore Park to West Lakes Shore

Mirani Court Site Compound

The Government of South Australia's Coast Park initiative aims to improve community access and enjoyment of our beaches through the establishment of a continuous 70 kilometre coastal Shared Use Path along the metropolitan coastline.

Construction of Coast Park Stage One, located between Third Avenue, Semaphore Park and the northern edge of the Wara Wayingga-Tennyson Dunes Conservation Reserve, will commence in April 2023.

In preparation for the start of construction, the contractor (McConnell Dowell) will begin setting up the site compound from mid April 2023, weather permitting. The main site office will be located on the western side of the Mirani Court car park. A map of the site compound and staff parking is provided on the next page.

This compound will contain site offices and amenities which will overlap both the carpark and the grassed area. The grassed area will be reinstated once the site compound is removed at the end of the project.

Some temporary pedestrian detours will be in place around the work site office and pedestrians are advised to follow directional signage. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Key Activities

During site set up, you may see:

- use of a crane truck and other small machinery;
- · increased traffic movement and traffic management as required;
- installation of temporary fencing, site offices and amenities; and
- set up of a pedestrian detour around the site compound.

How will these works affect me?

Once construction has commenced, the compound will generally be occupied between 7am and 5pm Monday to Friday, and Saturdays from 8am to 2pm, when possible. The compound will be securely locked outside of these working hours.

Vehicle access to the site compound will be via Mirani Court, with traffic management set up onsite when necessary. Please be aware of any changes in traffic conditions.

Temporary staff car parking will be allocated at the Mirani Court car park, for key project personnel. The extent of this staff parking will be reduced or removed on weekends.

The compound will be used for the duration of the project, which is expected to be completed in October 2023, weather permitting.

Whilst there will be some temporary impacts for pedestrians and cyclists, access will be maintained at all times, with traffic controllers onsite to assist. The Coast Park project team will work closely with the community to address any concerns or issues raised during construction.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.
