Cape Jervis and Kangaroo Island Ports Upgrade

Cape Jervis Works – Piling Update

We're upgrading the Penneshaw and Cape Jervis ports, making trips to and from Kangaroo Island quicker and safer.

This project is funded by the South Australian Government.

What's happening

Work to construct the 14 new piles will commence soon at the Cape Jervis port. Piling will be undertaken from both land and from purpose-built barges on the water.

To ensure everyone's safety and access to ferry services is maintained, these works will be at night.

Night works will regularly be undertaken throughout the works program, in addition to the day works schedule.

How this affects you

Some noise can be expected; however, we will make every effort to minimise impacts as much as possible.

We will use a *bored piling* method, commonly used when heavy foundations and deep excavations are required in close proximity to existing buildings. More information about piling can be found in the Frequently Asked Questions at <u>www.dit.sa.gov.au/KIPorts</u>

Lighting will be directed towards work areas only, and the noisiest works will be undertaken in the early evening where practicable. We encourage you to subscribe for project updates and notifications to stay informed about future works.
