

# Augusta Highway Duplication

## Augusta Highway and Nantawarra Road intersection lighting Installation

**We're upgrading the Augusta Highway to boost economic growth, improve safety and freight access.**

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$260 million (80:20) to the Augusta Highway Duplication Project.

### What's happening

We are installing new solar lighting at the intersection of the Augusta Highway, Nantawarra Road and Catford Road to improve safety for all road users.

### How this affects you

To do this work safely, we will have speed and lane restrictions in place throughout work areas.

Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signage.

Outside of work hours, speed and lane restrictions will be removed.

**The Augusta Highway will remain open at all times.**

Monday to Friday between the hours of 7am and 7pm

The intersection of Augusta Highway, Nantawarra Road and Catford Road, Nantawarra
