Renmark works notice

We are undertaking flood recovery works at multiple locations in Renmark

These works are funded as part of the River Murray Flood Recovery Program.

What's happening

Resurfacing and kerb repair works will be undertaken in Renmark on Bookmark Bridge (Sturt Highway), Ral Ral Avenue, Renmark Avenue and the Ral Ral Avenue bridge footpath. Please see work zone map overleaf for more information.

These works will improve safety and amenity for all road users.

How this affects you

To keep everyone safe there will be changes to existing traffic conditions as required as works move progressively between the three work zones.

Speed restrictions will remain in place until all works, including line marking, are fully complete in early December 2024, weather permitting.

Please plan your trip, observe signage and follow the direction of on-site traffic controllers.

Ral Ral Avenue and Renmark Avenue

Commencing from Monday 28 October 2024, works on Ral Ral Avenue and Renmark Avenue will be undertaken day and night. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the area for the duration of works.

Short term local road detours will be required intermittently. Please observe onsite signage and follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Some property access may be temporarily restricted during works. Affected property owners, residents, and businesses will be contacted directly in advance.

Pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained at all times.

Some restrictions to on street parking will be required.

Ral Ral Avenue Bridge footpath

Ral Ral Avenue Bridge works will be undertaken at night, with the footpath on Ral Ral Avenue Bridge closed for the duration of bridge works.

During working hours, Ral Ral Avenue Bridge will be reduced to one lane of traffic across the bridge with traffic controllers in place to control the direction of traffic. Speed restrictions will also be in place. Please follow onsite traffic controller directions and drive carefully around workers.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when moving through the area, follow local signage and the direction of traffic controllers.

Outside of working hours, traffic restrictions will be lifted, and returned to normal conditions however the footpath will remain closed for the duration of works.

Sturt Highway – Bookmark Creek Bridge closure and detour

Works on the Sturt Highway at the Bookmark Creek Bridge will be undertaken at night on Sunday, 3 November 2024 and Monday, 4 November 2024.

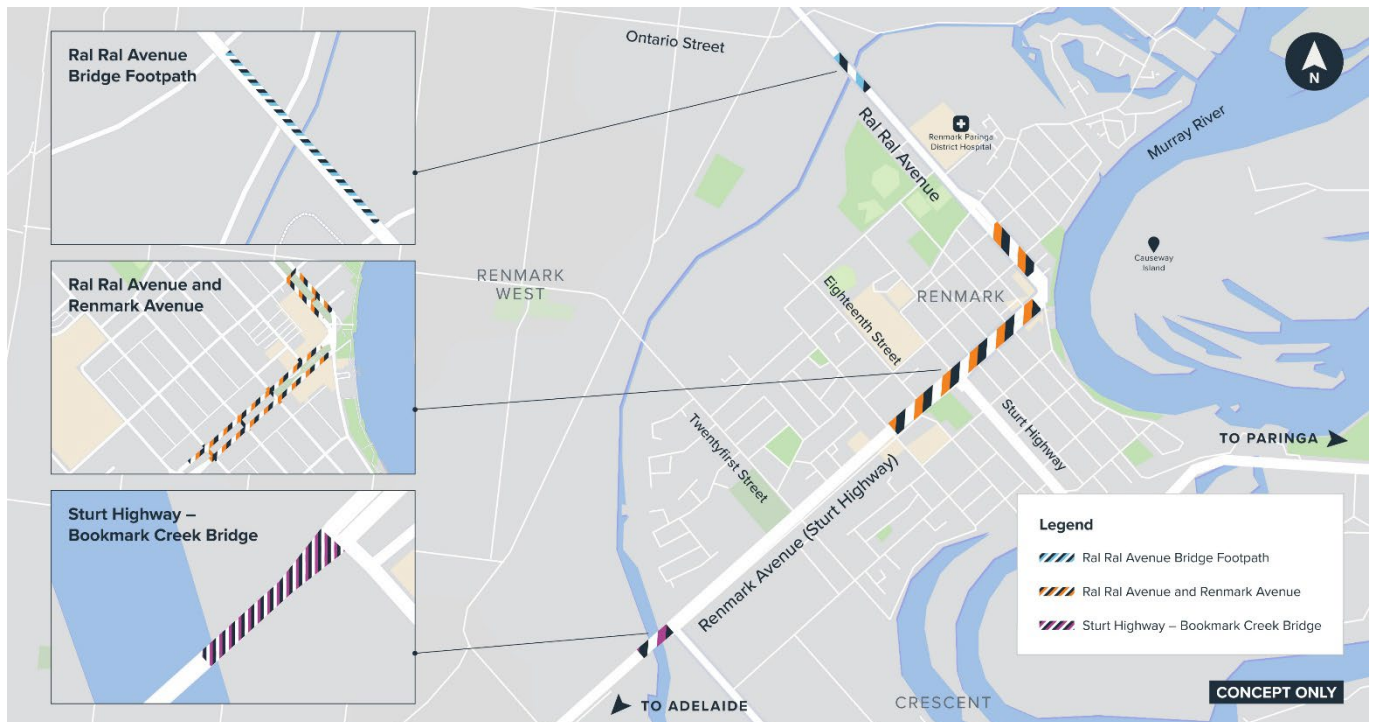
During working hours both lanes will be closed on the bridge, with detours for all vehicles in place. Please follow onsite traffic controller directions and drive carefully around workers.

Heavy vehicles will be detoured via Government Road and Ontario Street when required. See detour map overleaf. Local access will be maintained.

Outside of working hours, Bookmark Creek Bridge will be reopened to two-way traffic with speed restrictions in place until all works are completed.

If works are unable to be carried out on the planned dates, works will be scheduled for the next evening, weather permitting.
