Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package

Main Road, Cherry Gardens – project update

We are delivering the Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package to upgrade key strategic arterial roads in the region.

The road improvements will support economic growth, improve road safety and increase fire resilience. The \$150 million initiative is jointly funded by the Australian Government (80%) and South Australian Government (20%) over five years.

What's happening

Major construction works along Main Road, Cherry Gardens are now complete. Completed works include road widening at nine identified curves, safety barriers installation, new kerb and gutters and road surface improvements.

Finishing works have now commenced following completion of major works. These works will include road signage installation, line marking, vegetation management and minor surface remediation.

These works are expected to be completed late December 2024.

Audio Tactile Line Marking will be completed in early 2025 after the Tour Down Under event. Advance notice will be provided.

ATLM is used to reduce "run-off-road' or cross carriageway crashes by creating a noise (audio) and vibratory (tactile) warning to road users who have strayed from the road lane.

How this affects you

Traffic on Main Road between Black Road and Chandlers Hill Road will be intermittently reduced to a single lane in sections where finishing works are being undertaken, speed restrictions will also be in place.
