Morphett Road Level Crossing Removal

Service investigations and relocations

We're raising the tram line over Morphett Road to get traffic moving

As part of the Tram Grade Separation Projects (TGSP), we are removing the level crossing at Morphett Road, Morphettville. This \$200 million level crossing removal project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments

What's happening

The next phase of survey, ground investigations and service relocations are now required.

Service investigations

Existing services in the area are required to be identified and surveyed to support design progress.

Survey and ground investigations will move progressively around the area and occur at each location for a short period. Locations include:

- near the level crossing and intersection of Morphett Road and Anzac Highway;
- Maxwell Terrace, Dunbar Terrace and along the Mike Turtur Bikeway; and
- within the tram corridor.

Service investigation works are planned to occur at night to reduce impacts to traffic and cyclists. Where possible, night works on local roads will be scheduled earlier in the evenings to reduce noise and disruption to residents.

A portion of investigation works along the Mike Turtur Bikeway, between Morphett Road and Park Terrace, Plympton Park will require the bikeway to be closed with a detour in place. Works have been staged to occur at night to reduce impacts to users. **The closure will commence from Sunday 24 November 2024 and be closed each night between 7pm and 5am for approximately one week. The bikeway will be fully reopened during the day.** Please see detour map overleaf.

Pedestrians and cyclists should take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Signage will be in place to direct you to alternative access or detours.

Service relocations

SA Power Networks are relocating a number of services underground at the intersection of Anzac Highway and Morphett Road and on Maxwell Terrace, between Sturt River and Morphett Road.

Additional service relocation works including telecommunications will occur within the footpath on the eastern side of Morphett Road, between the level crossing and Bray Street, Morphettville. Properties adjacent will be directly notified in advance of works occurring.

To minimise impacts to traffic and tram services, working hours will continue to be a combination of day and night works.

Works on Morphett Road and Anzac Highway are planned to occur at night to reduce impacts to traffic and cyclists.

Works on Maxwell Terrace are planned to occur during the day to minimise impacts to residents. If nightworks are required to finalise the works, adjacent properties will be notified directly.

Some minor outages may be required to facilitate these works. SA Power Networks will directly notify affected properties in advance (SA Power Networks phone: 13 12 61).

Pedestrians and cyclists should take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access, with signage in place for alternative access and/or detours.

How this affects you

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place while works are underway. Please follow onsite signage and traffic controllers.

Access to properties will be maintained during the works wherever possible. Some short-term property access restrictions may be required with advance notice provided.

Access to Tram Stop 12 (Morphett Road) and Tram Stop 11 (Plympton Park), will be maintained at all times. There will be no impacts to tram stops or services as part of these activities.

During these works there may be some noise disruptions, however we will minimise these where possible.

There are no planned works during the holiday period from late December 2024 until early January 2025. SA Power Networks' service relocation works will recommence from early January 2025, and we will provide information on these works closer to the time.
