Regional Bridges Upgrade Rocky River Bridge Update

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure's (DPTI) will upgrade the Rocky River Bridge on the Augusta Highway near Crystal Brook. This is part of the \$40 million Australian Government and State Government funded Regional Bridges Upgrade Program and will improve road safety and increase freight efficiency by upgrading a number of bridges across South Australia's regional road network.

Works are scheduled to commence from Monday **21 January 2019 and are expected to be completed by late June 2019,** weather permitting, and will include:

- bridge and road shoulder widening
- installation of new guard rails and bridge barriers

Works will be undertaken from 7am to 5pm, starting on Monday morning and finishing on Saturday afternoon each week until the completion of the Project.

Traffic diversion and speed restrictions will be in place adjacent the Rocky River Bridge available for all traffic throughout the course of the works. Road users are advised to follow the direction of traffic management staff and observe signage.

DPTI appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
