Inverbrackie Bridge Upgrade

Regional Bridges Upgrade Program

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) is upgrading the Inverbrackie Bridge and Riverview Road junction, Onkaparinga Valley Road, between Woodside and Oakbank.

This work forms part of the \$40 million Australian Government and State Government funded Regional Bridges Upgrade Program, which will improve road safety and increase freight efficiency by upgrading a number of bridges across South Australia's regional road network.

Works on the Inverbrackie Bridge and adjacent road junction are scheduled to commence on Friday, **15 March**, and are expected to be completed by July, weather permitting, and will involve:

- replacing the existing bridge with wider structures
- installation of new guard rails and bridge barriers

Works will be undertaken 7am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday each week until the completion of the project.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times throughout the works and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users wherever possible.

Traffic diversions and speed restrictions will be in place for the duration of the works, as shown on the attached map.

Road users are advised to follow the direction of traffic management staff and observe signage.

Members of the Project team will be available to provide information and discuss the project with the public at the Woodside Library on Thursday 7 March between 10am and 1pm.
