Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade Site investigation Works

Dear Resident / Business Owner,

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) will be upgrading the intersection of Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$35 million project is jointly funded by the South Australian and Australian governments.

We have received valuable feedback from the local community over the past year, and this has been provided to our engineering and design consultants for consideration as the preferred concept design is developed. Thank you to everyone who provided feedback. Once a preferred concept design is ready, we will provide another update.

In order to progress with design development, site investigation works will be undertaken in the vicinity of the intersection. Works are expected to commence on Wednesday 16 September and be complete by early October, weather permitting. Works will include:

- Location of underground services, and
- Geotechnical drilling.

Drilling works will be undertaken during the day, between the hours of 10am and 3pm. While some noise can be expected during drilling works, effort will be made to minimise the disturbance.

Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road will remain open during works, however temporary lane and speed restrictions may be required when workers are on site.

Temporary footpath and bicycle lane detours may also be required. If this is the case, directional signage will be in place to guide people walking and riding. Bus stops will not be impacted.

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe traffic management signs, speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties and businesses in the area will be maintained at all times during works. Access through the area for emergency services will also be maintained at all times.
