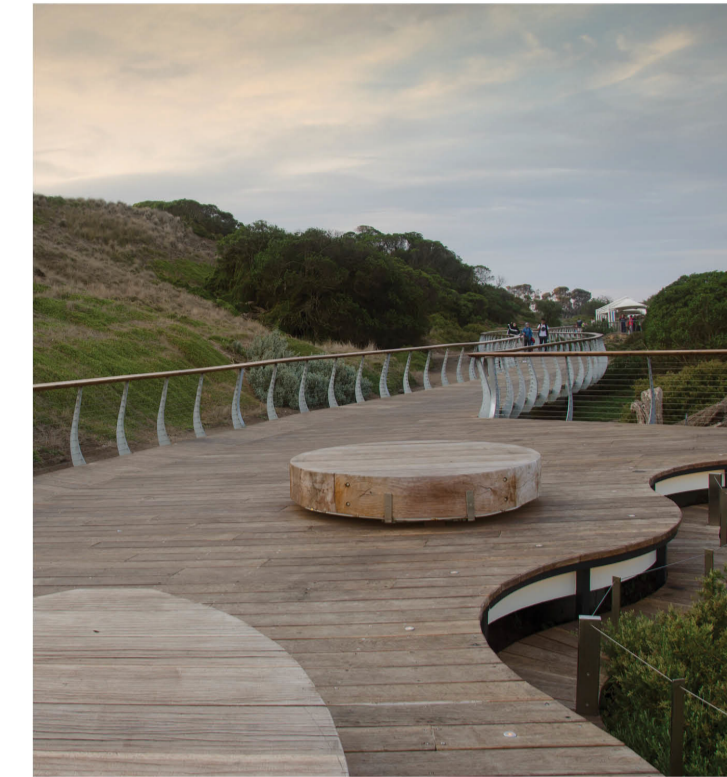


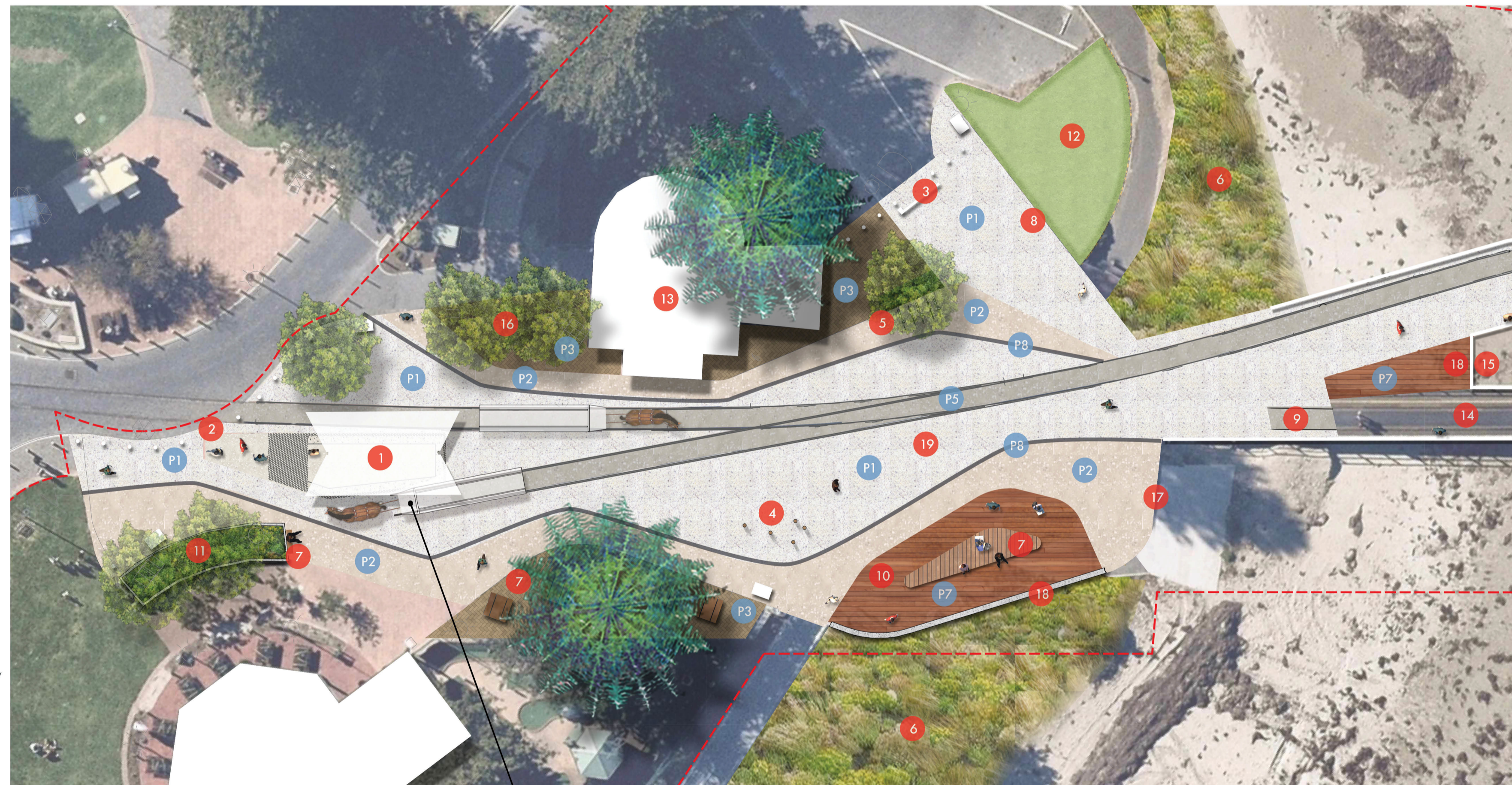


Victor Harbor Landing



LEGEND

- 1 New relocated tram stop
- 2 Existing fixed + removable bollards to be retained
- 3 Boom gate protected and retained
- 4 Cultural/historical/art opportunities using up-cycled timber from decommissioned causeway - opportunity for interpretive signage
- 5 Bike racks
- 6 Dune vegetation remediation - refer to planting palette for indicative plant varieties (WGA200469-RP-UD-0004)
- 7 Public furniture
- 8 Bike hire station retained and relocated
- 9 Old causeway tracks to be retained + embedded in new pavement (extent shown indicatively)
- 10 Viewing deck. Cultural gathering space
- 11 Protected and retained raised garden bed, partially altered to allow for new tram stop location. New planting and trees added to maximise sight line to Granite Island - refer to planting palette for indicative plant varieties
- 12 Lawn area to facilitate horse unloaded from carpark and access to stables
- 13 Horse stables and tramway building
- 14 Partial retention + reconstruction of old causeway jetty
- 15 Terminate existing handrail and tie into new
- 16 Planter and trees - opportunity to adjust arrangement in conversation with tram operation requirements - refer to planting palette for indicative plant varieties
- 17 Beach access retained
- 18 Interpretive signage
- 19 Exposed aggregate pavement + feature paving to tie into causeway deck

- P1 Exposed aggregate concrete
- P2 Exposed aggregate concrete
- P3 Concrete unit pavers
- P5 Equestrian matting
- P7 Hardwood or composite timber deck
- P8 Steel Inlays
