Portrush and Magill Roads Intersection Upgrade

Night Works

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading the intersection of Portrush and Magill roads to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$98 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

Road

Following the recent traffic switch to the new alignment, night works will be undertaken from **Wednesday**, **15 December 2021** to construct new kerb and median islands, adjust top stones, and to install new road lighting, signal and stormwater infrastructure. These works will be undertaken at the intersection and on all approaches to the intersection.

Hours of work are between 7pm and 6am, from Sunday to Thursday. No works will be undertaken on Friday and Saturday nights.

There will be a site shutdown over the holiday period, between Thursday 23 December and Tuesday, 4 January 2022, where no works will be undertaken. Nightworks will recommence following this break and an updated notification will be sent just prior to the shutdown period.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed. However, every effort will be made to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

To safely facilitate these works, changed traffic conditions including speed and lane restrictions will be in place. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons the footpath and bike lane on the western side of Portrush Road will remain closed between Beulah Road and Dover Street. Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Every effort will be made to minimise impact to the community and access to properties will be maintained throughout these works.

There is no change to public transport services.
